The items below are the most common things that an Explorer would need to bring to camp. The items not bolded are optional.

## WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Duffle Bag and Backpack  
Warm Sleeping Bag or Three (3) Blankets  
Poncho, Raincoat, or Rain Jacket  
Waterproof Footwear/Sandals  
Comfortable Hiking Boots  
Extra Shoes  
Explorer Uniform  
Clothing Bag containing:  
- Socks (1 per day)  
- T-shirts  
- Sweat Shirt (it gets cold at night)  
- Underwear (1 per day)  
- Jeans or Long Pants  
- Pajamas or Sweats  
Toilet Kit containing:  
- Toothbrush and toothpaste  
- Comb and/or Brush  
  
Insect Repellent  
Canteen/Water Bottle  
AA Battery Flashlight with extra batteries and bulbs (it gets dark)  
Pen (black) and notebook  
Wrist Watch  
Alarm Clock  
Sunglasses  
Sun Block
